

MOLECHASER

KEEP BURROWING RODENTS OUT OF YOUR GARDEN FOREVER

New MOLECHASER is the most humane and environmentally friendly way of keeping gardens and lawns free of destructive ground rodents.

Most underground rodents have poor eyesight but to make up, nature has given them a very acute sense of hearing and sensitivity to ground vibration. The MOLECHASER exploits this sensitivity to produce a penetration sonic sound 300Hz over an area of approx. 1,000 sq. metres at 15 second intervals. This frightens and irritates the rodents sometimes causing them to dig more frantically to try and secape the noise. Eventually, however, the noise proves too much and they move on to new and quieter pastures.

MOLECHASER is completely harmless to worms and other underground bugs.

- MOLECHASER operates in a circular pattern, approx. 36 metres in diameter. This must be an unobstructed 36 metres.
- Place MOLECHASER at site of worst rodent infestation.
- Replace battery after approximately 4-6 months or when sound is no longer audible.

BURROWING RODENTS AFFECTED:

- Moles
- Ground Squirrels
- Also, Shrews, Voles, Pocket Mice and Gophers

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

- (1) To open, unscrew green top cover anti-clockwise
- (2) Remove battery box and insert 4x1.5V batteries as indicated. If battery installation is correct, you should hear the first vibrating sound within 15 seconds.
- (3) After ensuring battery installation is correct, replace Battery Box and tighten Top Cover to ensure 100% maximum weather protection.
- (4) Insert MOLECHASER into the ground up to the Corrugated Portion. Your MOLECHASER will work day and night.

The unit will work for 4-6 months on one set of alkaline batteries. To replace batteries simply repeat steps 1-3 Please note damaged lawns, shrubs, etc will take up to 6 weeks to rejuvenate
New ground rodents will not appear.

IMPORTANT:

- (1) Top cover of MOLECHASER must be tightened again after insertion into the ground so there can be no possibility of water damage.
- (2) Make a pilot hole before inserting MOLECHASER into hard ground. **Do not hammer or push excessively or you may damage unit.**
- (3) Range of effectiveness depends largely upon soil type: Dry, sandy, or peat soil does not conduct the sonic eaves easily and sometimes two molechasers may be required. Moist clay is the best conductor of sound.
- (4) Do not expect instant reaction. MOLECHASER must be used continuously for up to 7 days before ground rodents start to move away from the area.

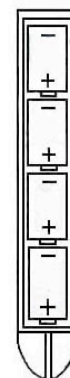
